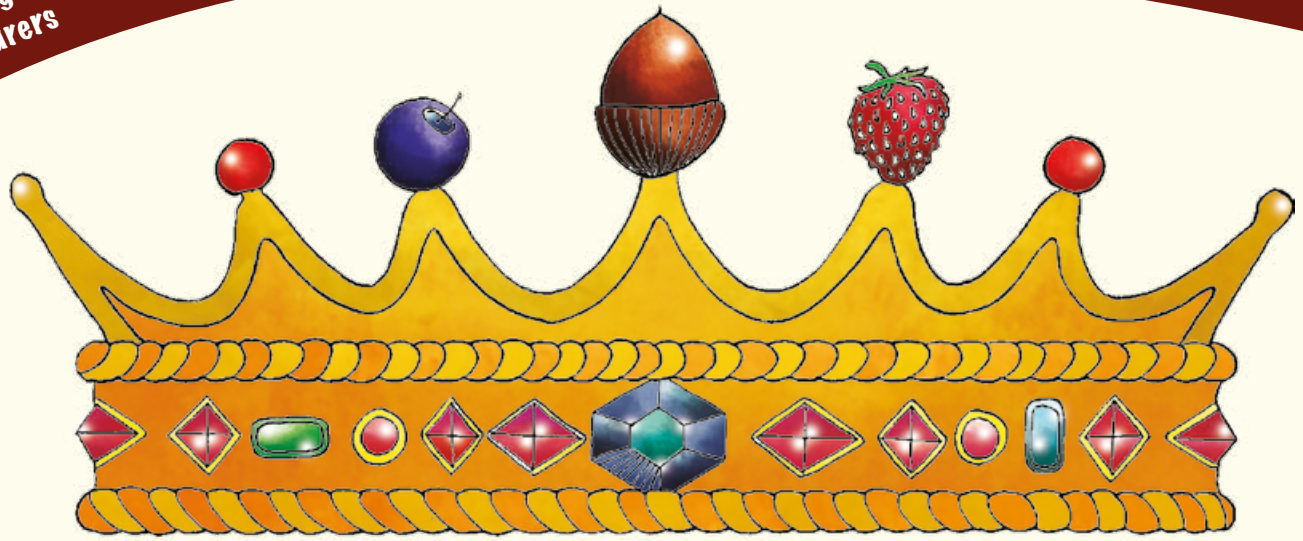

Has the goldsmith been a bit tired, do you think, when he has forged that crown above?

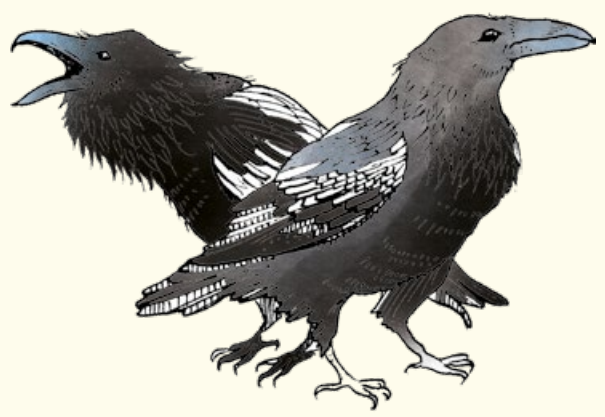
The right and the left sides of the crown are slightly different. Can you find 3 differences?

Make laws for a happy kingdom, such laws, that every one of you lawmakers can be pleased with.

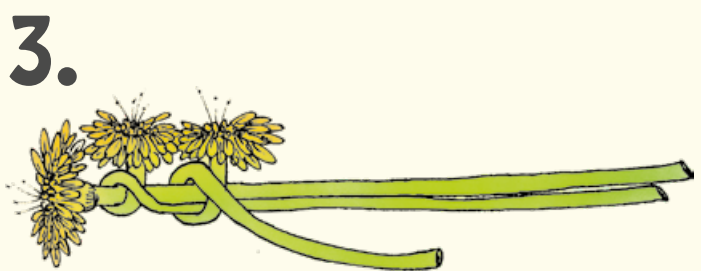
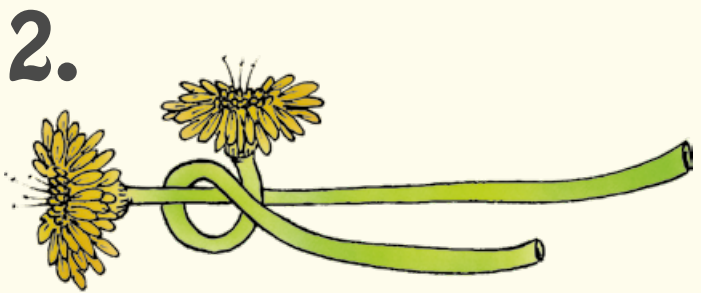
For example: "Monday is the most boring day of the week. That is why everyone should wear their most colourful clothes on Mondays." Think of 5 different laws.

4. FLOWERS FOR THE CROWNED

Tie your own crown-garland out of flowers and hay.

Only collect the kind of flowers that you find many of and are not protected. Take the flowers with the longest stems! When the garland is long enough, tie the ends together with a string of hay.

5. THE STATUE OF THE KING

Every great king has his statue.

Taking turns, one of you is an artist and the others are statues.

1. The artist takes a firm grip of the statue's hand and spins the statue around themselves. Make sure you are on a flat ground and have plenty of space around you!
2. The artist lets go of the statue's hand and the statue keeps on moving. The artist says STOP and the statue tries to stop into the posture where they were when they heard the word stop.
3. Now the artist tells about their statue. Is the statue presenting the king spending time with his favourite hobby, or what is he up to?
